This is a super little program for digital stills camera users or those of you like me who often make up stills sequences for presentation in various ways. The link is now on our website and allows you to download the full program for free with the only restriction being on a maximum of 10 slides. If you want to lift that restriction then pay just about £15 with VAT and they unlock your existing program. The latest version even allows you to make up a slide show complete with sound, all manner of transitions etc and convert it direct to a .avi for import to premiere. But the real gem of the program comes from its name. The program outputs your complete show direct to an executable .exe file on a CD. Just give to anyone with a PC and it plays – full screen, lovely quality, sound'n'all. It doesn't need a player application. For fifteen quid it's a steal! To see what it'll do have a look at one of the sample shows from the website link. The one I like is Cinque Terre, about the Italian Riviera Coast. Gorgeous.
