Tony is also planning to run the session in a very interactive style and will welcome much audience participation. Could you all please give thought to some useful questions to make the evening even more informative and enjoyable.

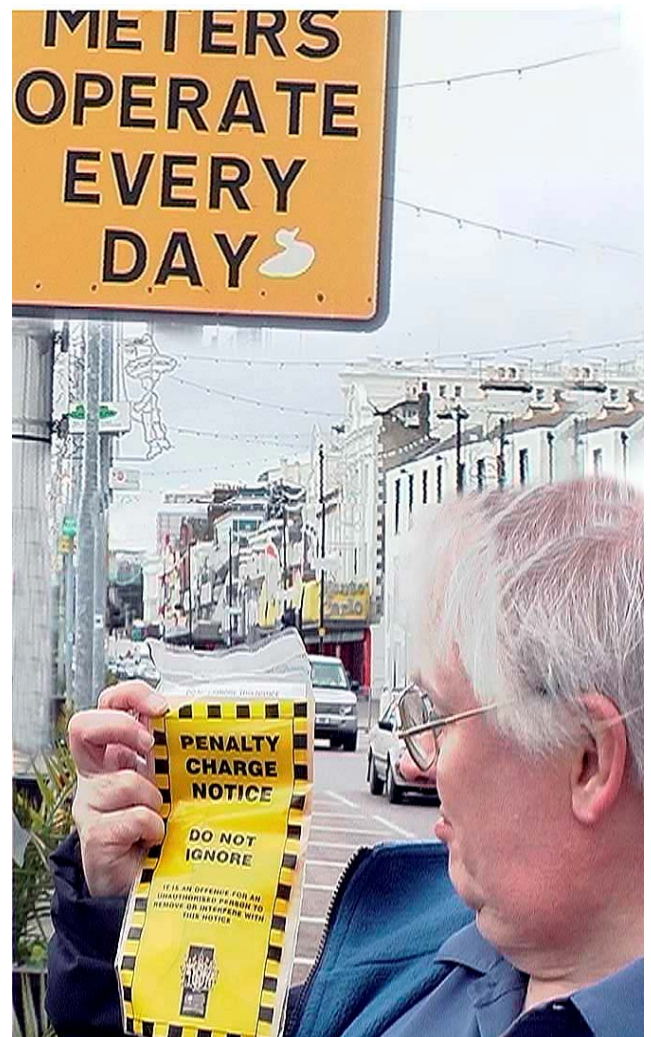
Important programme changes for your diary!
