There will be three films shown from each club in the following categories; Documentary, Open and the set theme round which this year is 'Wrong Number'.

To make the competition even more exciting 'Westcliff' are looking to win it for the third year in succession. If we manage to do so it will be the first time this has ever been achieved in the competitions history.

Westcliff will be showing the Lester Redding film 'Moab' in the open section and the moving documentary by Terry & Debbie Mendoza 'Side by Side'. For the 'Set Theme' a small group from Westcliff, headed up by Lester and Terry have made a film for this section entitled 'Numbers'. With the other six entries making a total of nine films with a total running time of about 93 minutes makes for a very entertaining and exciting way to spend a Sunday afternoon.

Three external judges will consider each entry and mark them in each round, three points for first, two for second and one point for third making a maximum of 27 points available over the three rounds. Now remember in the semi-final Westcliff managed 26 out of 27.....hope that's not tempting fate. The three judges will be Norman Saville, David Wyatt and Philip Beasley and Ron Jones of the IAC will be the referee in attendance.
